Multi-Factor Authentication:

- Three pillars of multi-factor authentication
 - *Something you know, a password*
 - *something you have, a key*
 - *something you inherently are, biometric ie. fingerprint*

Two Factor Authentication:

- Uses two of the above factors. The idea is that it should be harder to steal two different factors than to steal one.

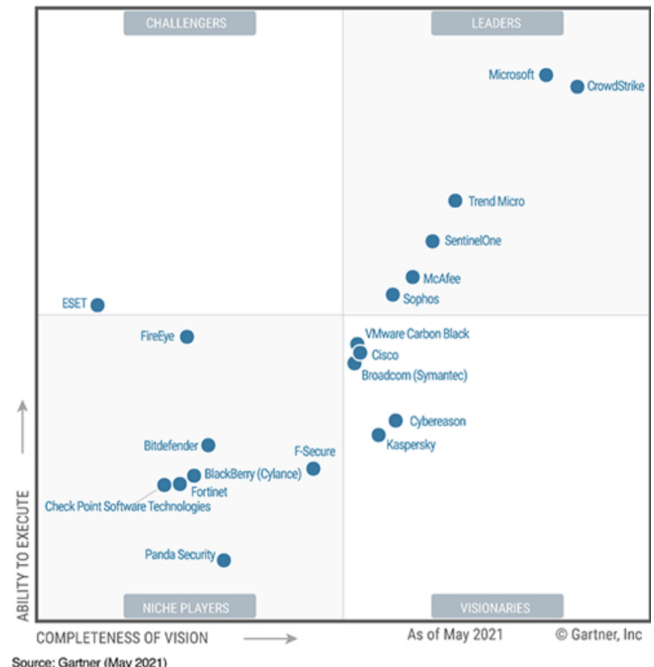
